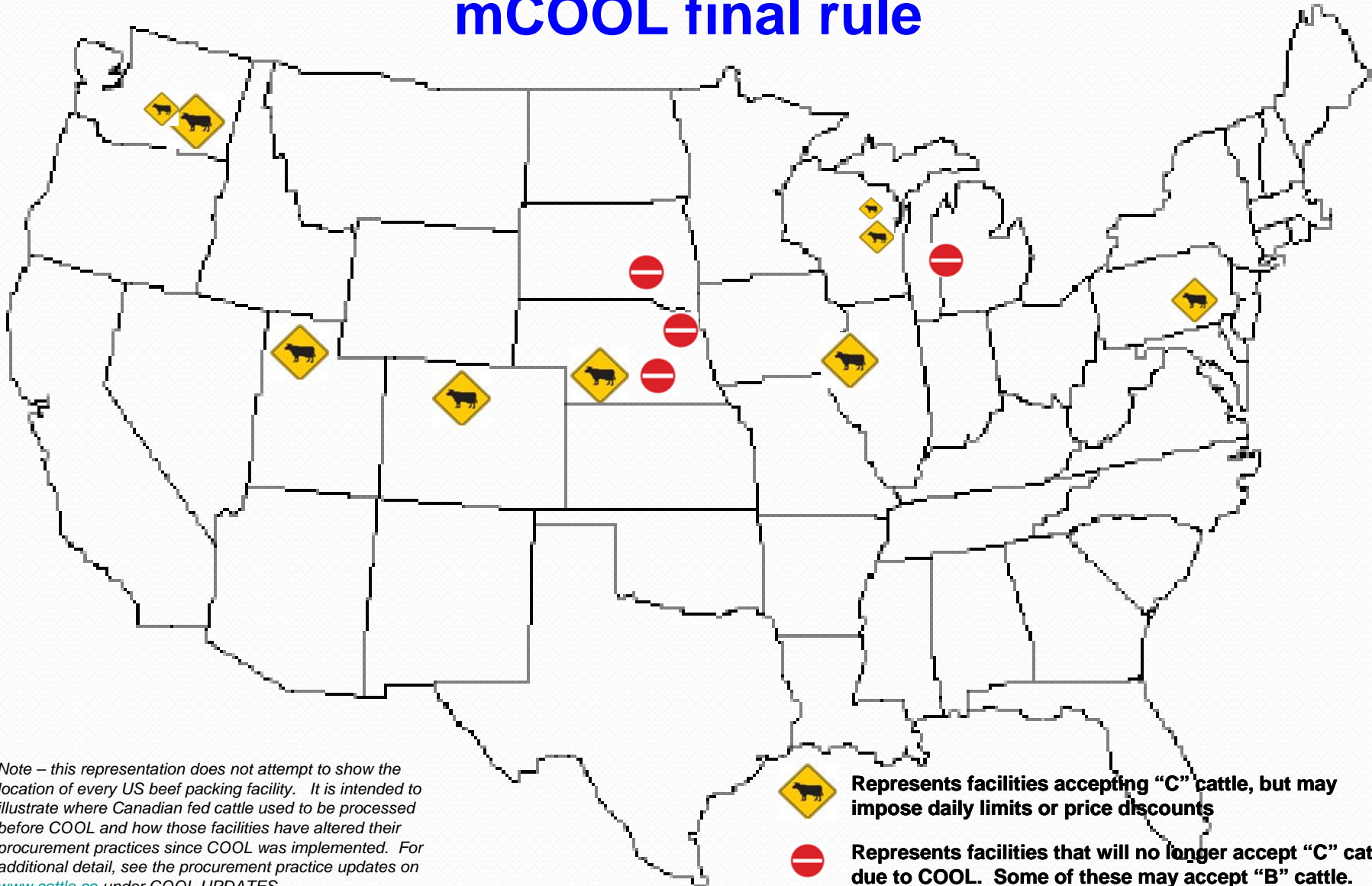




U.S. packer procurement of “C” cattle under mCOOL final rule



Note – this representation does not attempt to show the location of every US beef packing facility. It is intended to illustrate where Canadian fed cattle used to be processed before COOL and how those facilities have altered their procurement practices since COOL was implemented.
